


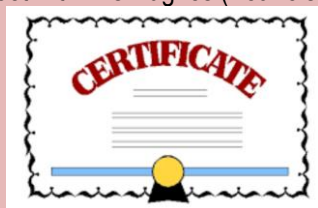
Prizegiving

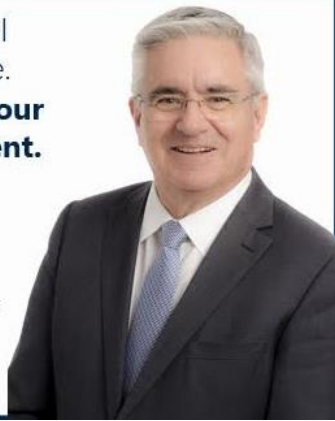
